We fully support you in your efforts to continue to build the important relationship and trust that NOAA Fisheries has with the councils. With your extensive background, you understand the importance of the council system, and the councils' work to provide sustainable fisheries, based on science and using a public collaborative process to engage with State and Federal agencies, Tribal representatives, fishermen, and other key stakeholders. We are committed to working closely with you and NOAA Fisheries in maintaining and building a robust fisheries management program for the nation.

Effective fisheries management, with strong scientific support, is particularly vital in the North Pacific. Alaska leads all states in both volume and value of U.S. landings. Each year, vessels homeported in coastal communities in Alaska, Washington, and Oregon harvest about 2,000,000 metric tons of groundfish in the North Pacific, worth approximately \$2.5 billion first wholesale. These catches, together with fish harvests from State waters, annually account for more than 60% of the total U.S. catch, and thus are critical to ensuring food security for the nation.

We would like to extend an open offer to call upon the Council, or its staff, at any time where we could be of assistance, including providing information on any issues that might arise during your tenure as Assistant Administrator.
