2022 WESTWARD COOPERATIVE AFA PERMIT	

2022 was Westward Fleet Cooperatives 23rd year of fishing under the America Fisheries Act (AFA). All vessels successfully executed their harvest plans. There were many intra-Cooperative transfers and inter-cooperative transfers which are included in the tables of this report. No vessel exceeded their post-transfer allocation limits and therefore no vessels received penalties from the Cooperative Board. For 2022 Marcus Alden served as the Cooperative President, Gregory Baker as the Vice President, Robert Desautel as the Executive Director, Elizabeth Reed as Secretary and Treasurer, and Timothy Cusick as Cooperative Manager.

2022 WESTWARD FLEET COOPERATIVE MEMBERSHIP

There were no changes to Cooperative Membership in 2022. Westward Fleet Cooperative has 19.380% of the In-Shore Allocation.

IN SEASON MANAGEMENT

During the season the Cooperative manager and Plant manager meet twice daily to contact the fleet and get the latest information on scheduling, bycatch concerns, and general fish quality information. At the end of each offload the Captain and the Cooperative manager receive the offload weight and Salmon bycatch numbers. The Cooperative manager then forwards this and any other relevant information on the offload to the Cooperative member vessels and any vessel fishing under an amendment 69 agreement. The Managing Members also directly communicate with the Captains and Cooperative manager on vessel operation concerns as well as bycatch and other concerns. All member vessels as well as the Plant and Cooperative manager receive Salmon bycatch alarms and Salmon closure notices directly from Seastate. In season inter and intra Cooperative transfers are made by the Cooperative manager on the approval of the Managing Members.

2022 WESTWARD FLEET COOPERATIVE DIRECTED POLLOCK FISHERY

In 2022 Westward Fleet Cooperative had a Bering Sea Pollock Allocation of 92,092.0 mt of Pollock. The cooperative Harvested 92,091.8mt of Pollock, 0.2 mt was left in the water. Table 1 shows each member vessels allocation percentage of the Cooperative as well as the inshore sector percentage. Table two shows allocations, transfers, and catch by member vessels and the Nordic Fury who fished under Amendment 69 contract. 96.2% of the Pollock harvest was from member vessels the other 3.8% was taken by the Nordic Fury. Table 3 shows deliveries that were made to Processors other than the Cooperatives associated processor Westward Seafoods. In accordance with Section 210(b)(6) of the AFA Westward Fleet Cooperative delivered more than 90.0% of its Pollock to Westward Seafoods. All Pollock was delivered within the state of Alaska.

BYCATCH AND BYCATCH MANAGEMENT IN THE DIRECTED BS POLLOCK FISHERY

Table 4 shows number of Bairdi, Other Tanner, Red King Crab, Chinook, and Other Salmon, as well, as the metric tons of Halibut Mortality and Herring. Table 5 breaks down the Chinook and Other Salmon bycatch by vessel and season, it also notes that there were no dirty 20 lists for B season 2022. Westward Fleet Cooperative participates in the SSIP as the approved shoreside IPA under Amendment 91, as amended by Amendment 110. Further details of that program and its incentives will be provided during the IPA report presented to the North Pacific Fisheries Management Council.

BEARING SEA SIDEBOARD LIMITS, CATCH, AND TRANSFERS

Westward Fleet Cooperative vessels participated in both the Bering Sea Pollock fishery and three vessels; the Caitlin Ann, Westward One, and Viking also participated in the BSAI Non-Exempt Trawl Cod Fishery. No Westward Fleet Cooperative Vessels are Gulf Exempt. Table 6 shows the PSC taken in the BSAI Cod fishery. Table 7 shows the Cod catch and other sideboard catch in the BSAI Cod fishery. Table 9 shows the Cooperatives BSAI sideboard limits, catch, and transfers.

GULF OF ALASKA SIDEBOARD LIMITS AND TRANSFERS

Table 10 shows the total 2022 AFA Catcher Vessel sideboard limits, for the GOA, that come from Table 19 of the 2022 Final Ground fish Specifications. Table 10 also shows Westward Fleet Cooperatives portion of those Sideboard. Westward Fleet Cooperative made no transfers of GOA sideboards in 2022. No Westward Fleet Cooperative vessels participated in any Gulf fisheries in 2022.

Each of the undersigned hereby certifies that each of its member vessels as identified on the attached Exhibit A: (i) is a "qualified catcher vessel" within the meaning of 50 CFR 679.4(6)(ii)(D); (ii) delivered more pollock to Westward Seafoods, Inc. than to any other AFA inshore processor or stationary floating processor in the last year in which the vessel engaged in directed fishing for pollock in the BSAI for delivery to the inshore sector; (iii) is otherwise eligible to fish for groundfish in the BSAI; (iv) has an AFA catcher vessel permit with an inshore endorsement; (v) has no permit sanctions or other type of sanctions against it that would prevent it from fishing for groundfish in the BSAI; and (vi) is named on a valid LLP permit authorizing the vessel to engage in trawling for pollock in the BSAI.

AGREEMENT TO PROCESS (2022)

THIS AGREEMENT TO PROCESS is entered into as of November 15, 2021, by WESTWARD SEAFOODS, INC., an Alaska corporation ("Westward"), with reference to the following facts:

- A. The American Fisheries Act (the "AFA") authorizes the Secretary of Commerce to reserve portions of the Bering Sea/Aleutian Islands ("BS/AI") pollock inshore directed fishing allowance for harvesting by members of qualifying fishery cooperatives.
- B. Under the AFA, a contract implementing a qualifying fishery cooperative must specify that (i) other than as permitted under Section 210(b)(6) of the AFA, the cooperative's catcher vessels will deliver pollock in the BS/AI directed pollock fishery only to the processor to which such vessels delivered more pollock than to any other AFA inshore processor in the last year in which the vessels engaged in directed fishing for pollock in the BS/AI for delivery to the inshore sector, and (ii) such processor has agreed to process such pollock.
- C. The owners of eighty percent (80%) of the catcher vessels that delivered more pollock to the Westward plant in Dutch Harbor, Alaska (the "Plant") than any other processor in the last year in which the vessels engaged in directed fishing for pollock for delivery to the inshore sector have agreed, subject to the provisions of Section 210(b)(6) of the AFA and related provisions in the Westward Fleet Cooperative (the "Cooperative") Membership Agreement, to deliver pollock from the inshore BS/AI directed pollock fishery only to the Plant.
- D. Westward is willing to agree to process the BS/AI directed pollock fishery harvest of the Cooperative's members' vessels, to enable the Cooperative to obtain an allocation of BS/AI pollock under Section 210 of the AFA.

NOW, THEREFORE, Westward hereby agrees to purchase and process pollock harvested in the BS/AI directed pollock fishery by the Cooperative's members' catcher vessels, on terms and conditions to be agreed upon by and between Westward and such vessels' owners. Westward hereby acknowledges and agrees that, pursuant to Section 210(b)(6) of the AFA, such vessels may deliver up to ten percent (10%) of the Cooperative's BS/AI pollock allocation to qualified shoreside processors other than Westward.
